

Message for church members and pastors.

Here is something I wrote to a church I had been going to for several months. After I wrote this I was kicked out of the church, by a deacon I thought was my friend. All my words of concern for the pastor's soul were reversed right on me. This was my third message. I figure God speaks in 3's and God was my template for three warnings. As pastors, people have a greater condemnation. It is a tremendous responsibility for being a pastor of a church to tell the truth. I think too many pastors get so involved in the building, the tithe, the band, stage, lights, sound system, idols or their own sweet voice, that they forget the reason they are pastors or the reason which is Jesus Christ. Churches quickly become businesses, and the tithe controls the message.

Who are you trying to please God Almighty or the people in the pews? So it is not Christ and enduring to the end. Is it not Christ and love your neighbor. What about Christ plus forgiveness. For me that was hard. I had to forgive some very evil people who I did not want to but God warned me through others and in a violent dream where I was killed. You are these people's shepherd and the sheep look to you for guidance. Is the tithe so important that you have to preach a smooth easy message that will send people straight to hell. You are such a beautiful wonderful man and your heart is into it but by your lips you speak blasphemy. Our LORD is coming soon and will you be one saying "LORD LORD look at my church and the stage and sound system I provided for you." God blessed you with your church. God blessed you with nice things. I don't care how much money you make or what car you drive. Did not our LORD bless King Solomon until he fell from God's grace and stepped into pride. Just remember Lazarus and the rich man too. Yes it is Christ +. It is our time, our money, our love, our works. Does not the Bible say:

(Jas 2:18) Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

(Jas 2:20) But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

(Jas 2:26) For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Do you really want to lead an entire church to hell and then what will you have? These are actual words in the Bible quoted from the King James Bible not to be confused with the NKJV or the NLT. God would probably let you slide for reading those Bibles but not for perverting the truth.

(2Co 9:6) But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

I too have read the Bible and Bible books like you may not have ever heard of. I study the Latin Vulgate, ancient Spanish from time to time, ancient Bibles back to the 1388 Wycliffe, Hebrew, Greek and Aramaic and a lot more. God gave me 20 years as a Christian, sane and insane, locked up and free, in and out of fear, and all in all God has taught me some major lessons. I do have authority to write this email as I have read the Bible cover to cover enough times in the King James primarily and other predated Bibles too. Yes I read the perverted NIV, the NIRV, the NKJV and other perverted modern Bibles. Church is a place for me to come and worship God. I may not sing all the songs but for me to hear the songs and everyone worshipping together is music for my ears. I'm not mad at you, I'm not saying you have to change but just here to say our LORD is returning and not on a date we will know. When he comes, and I don't think anyone knows or understands how or when, He will do so in a way I don't think anyone is expecting. Have you really contemplated the words in the old building above the drinking fountain? I will repeat the verse. I would do more but I have to write another one of these to another pastor of a different church.

(Isa 42:9) Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them.

I think a lot of times we look at verses like they are a novelty item. In the above verse God is planning something different. Often I don't share my perspectives on the Bible because some might say I have a private interpretation. God has given me guidance, help, and wisdom in the Bible because I asked for it but then I had to work for it diligently. You have excelled far greater than I ever did. You have the ability to memorize, a great charisma, and a great orator. You are a brilliant man but you are leading people to damnation by saying there is no plus. Cheap grace or hyper-grace doesn't work with God. Demons do reside in Christians and we are learning how to cast them out. When dealing with the adversary is the closer we walk with God the more our lives are protected.

(Jas 4:8) Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Blood is on my head right now because I have to warn you. God gave me the following verse in a dream as plain as day several years ago.

(Eze 33:3) If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet, and warn the people;

I have a church but it is online and I have spent eleven years building it. I have prepared my soil for the harvest. I've shared with widows and I bless orphans and that is not to brag but rather a command from Jesus Christ. I do what I can do, and to be honest if you really knew me you'd tell me to cast the beam out of my eye first. What I teach, to people that I expect to one day come to my sites, is a relationship with Jesus. If you saw my sites you'd might think to yourself they are poorly made and poorly worded. They are not high dollar sites but they pour out Bible truth in a labor of love.

I've spent my time in the trenches. I know everyone pastoring churches is aligned with you. They all teach modern Bibles, smooth messages, cool words, well they did on the Titanic too. Oh this ship is unsinkable, not even God can sink it, but he did and many people perished. Not everyone goes to heaven. Not with vain words that are forgotten by the end of the day, baptism isn't a guarantee of salvation, reading the Bible each day can make one a Pharisee. Paying a tithe won't get you there either. It is God's grace not our own but we often feel we own it. Three verses go together and should not be separated. We always tend to look at verses 8-9 all the time. We even see them on salvation cards. God gave us a Bible to read not a salvation card. He even made it easy on us by removing the apocrypha which I have only read a fraction of because I wanted to concentrate on the first 66 books. So let us look at the following verses and closely examine them.

(Eph 2:8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

(Eph 2:9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

(Eph 2:10) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Underlining my emphasis. No grace is not ours it is the gift of God which God choses to give as he wills.

(Joh 5:21) For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.

It is God's choice who gets resurrected not ours. Furthermore:

(Dan 4:35) And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?

Are you or 90% percent or more of the other pastors really going to look at God and ask him what are you doing??? Our God has a master plan and I am seeing it clearly. Of course I don't know the date or hour because I am not God but rather your friend who sees you making the same mistake everyone else is making. The bottom line is it is your church and you can run it to please either man or our God. The choice is yours as we all have freewill. I watched you preach sermons that were good as you mentioned a responsibility to God: What I heard Wednesday was second only to the Baptist pastors in jail back in 1998 where they preached "once saved always saved." I knew something was real fishy when I asked "you mean I can launch a nuclear missile kill a million people and still go to heaven." The answer was "as long as you are saved you will go to heaven." I feel sorry for those pastors. You would not believe the hell they created for us in the pod. Inmates became 100 times worse, never returned to church and never repented and you could never talk to them about God ever again.

(Jud 1:4) For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

The only reason I am sending this is because you have a heart. You are receptive. My old church the SDA church, was strict on Sabbath, yet had the "authority" to change the feast days, and taught a message of hyper-grace too. While I do their janitorial service for free once and sometimes twice a week, I completely gave up on them and warned them for the last time too. There is a pattern of speaking and God outlines it three times in his Word. It is my guide for a lot of things. After this message I will silence myself and never say a thing to you again about your preaching style.

(Job 40:5) Once have I spoken; but I will not answer: yea, twice; but I will proceed no further.

The final choice is yours.

(Jos 24:15) And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

If you have the courage you can share this email with Bethel since they are teaching, in my opinion, far worse than you are. You can also send it to your other pastors in town. We can get a revival going if people realize that repentance is a key player in salvation.

In 1998 under the stars at night I knew I needed more than what I had been relying on which was nothing. I said to God not even knowing who he was, "God if you get me through this I will be a

preacher for you." I am not allowed to preach anywhere other than the websites I own, because my message is true. I never realized our God would have me preach to pastors. It is your decision to pass this message on, read it, kick me out of your church, or tell me to go to hell, or receive it. Just remember the words that were given to Johnathan Chan who when given the Harbinger by God was told afterward:

(Eze 33:6) But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.

You might want to pray about this message whether it is of God, or a message I wrote to aggravate you and for me as the Pharisees of Jesus time kick me out of the Synagogue. I write this message as a message of love and one in peace. Though my words are weighty I wonder sometimes; am I speaking for God? That is for you to decide.

(Pro 10:12) Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.

(1Co 13:1) Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

(1Co 13:2) And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

(1Co 13:3) And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

What is the Apostle Paul really preaching here. We can do it all and see it all but if we don't have love we are nothing. It's late and I'm tired and not doing this for my health and I have to get up early. If I can

figure out the other church I have to work even harder with that email. If I don't do this now I fear I will lose my salvation and go to hell. You might not worry about the following verse but I do:

(Php 2:12) Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

LORD Jesus if I have said anything out of line: If I have worded anything incorrectly: If I have somehow unknowingly promoted myself: Then I ask you to crash my internet now so this message can't be sent.
